




### FY05 SUCCESSES

- Effective partnering with ODEP, AEC, and IMA to revise guidance; specifically Compliance-related Cleanup (CC), Cost-to Complete (CTC), and Installation Action Plan (IAP).
- Developed funding policy to help maximize constrained CC resources.
- Received approval of CC POM build methodology that captures unfunded FY06 and FY07 requirements and distributes them through the POM years
- Camp Navajo PBC contract is on track to achieve response complete/remedy in place (RIP/RC) at the seven remaining IRP sites by December 2006.
- Clarified regulatory bounds of cleanup under SDWA at MMR.

## ARNG FY06 Goals

- Continue to improve the quality of AEDB-CC input in preparation for qualified audit in FY07.
- Update Environmental Site Assessments, Environmental Baseline Surveys, and Environmental Condition of Property procedures to reflect new EPA guidance regarding “All Appropriate Inquiry”.
- Focus on execution of PBC contracts at the remaining NGB IRP sites to help ensure RIP/RC is achieved.
- Review and update the CC PMP to reflect policy and strategy changes.

## ARNG CLEANUP PROGRAM CHALLENGES

- Approach for addressing potential cleanup sites resulting from the operational range survey.
- Ensuring VENC funding dedicated to CC sites does not migrate to other projects.
- Policy/Approach for integration of DoD non-DERP  
“Guidance For Recognizing, Measuring and Reporting Environmental Liabilities.....”

## Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) 05

- ARNG has currently identified 269 BRAC actions from FY06 to FY10
  - Build - 44
  - Closure - 207
  - Realignment - 18
- Majority of actions are armory closures
  - Precise number and location of closures are at the discretion of the State's Adjutant General
- All federal BRAC actions will require NEPA documentation
  - EA – 32
  - EIS - 0
  - REC- 237
- Potential Issues
  - Delay of Funding Availability – Requires NEPA documents to be developed by in-house staff
  - Synchronization/Coordination of documents between Cleanup (EBS/ESA/ECP) and NEPA (REC/EA)
